C2C/181st Corridor

Build a new road to connect 172 nd Avenue to 190 th Avenue.	\$40-50M
Adding auto lanes and multimodal features to 172 nd and 190 th Avenues to better serve all people using the corridor, which may include enhanced pedestrian crossings, bike lanes and options to help public transit move more efficiently.	\$35-40 (172 nd) and \$50-60M (190 th)
Adding turn lanes at the Powell Boulevard intersection.	\$3-5M
Enhanced Transit Corridor (ETC) elements on 181 st such as Business Access Transit (BAT) lanes.	\$15M
Safety improvements on 181 st Avenue.	\$10-15M
Improvements (roundabout) to the 172 nd Avenue and Foster Road intersection.	\$4-5M

Boulevard improvements in Oregon City for walkability.	\$1M (plan)
Reedway Street pedestrian/bicycle overcrossing.	\$10-20M
Kellogg Creek Dam removal and pedestrian underpass.	\$10-20M
Expand Park Avenue Park & Ride Station.	\$25-30M
I-205 ramp intersection improvements	\$5-10M
(Trolley Trail crossing over Clackamas River	\$1M (plan)
Systemic safety improvements between Milwaukie and Oregon City. Includes improved pedestrian crossings, sidewalk infill, buffered bicycle lanes, lighting improvements.	\$10-15M
Enhanced transit corridor (ETC) elements such as bypass lanes, business access transit (BAT) lanes, and bus shelters.	\$60-65M

Highway 212/ Sunrise Corridor

Extend Sunrise as a 2-lane highway with a multi-use path to 172 nd Avenue	\$300M
Extend Sunrise as a 4-lane highway with a multi-use path to 172 nd Avenue	\$370M
